

To: Log Hill Village Residents

There are, currently, three trails along the escarpment through Lot 1A. The approved trail begins on Park property a few yards east of the private Fire Board lots (sold by the Fire Board to fund the new fire station), turns north and returns to the escarpment trail a few yards west of those lots. It was sanctioned by the Fire Board and constructed by the Park Board.

The old Escarpment Trail trespasses on private property and has been abandoned. The third trail was built by unknown parties. It drops over the escarpment, on park property, just east of the edge of Lot 1A and returns to the escarpment trail just west of the Fire Board lots. It is steep and not recommended by the Park Board - use at your own risk.

Someone has taken serious objection to the abandonment of the old escarpment trail, and has taken it upon themselves to close the legitimate trail around the Fire Board lots with logs and rocks, move the signs indicating the legitimate trail, and place them to indicate the trail continues along the escarpment through private property. The Park Board has corrected the signage and rock/log arrangement several times, to no avail.

Please familiarize yourself with the legitimate trail and use it rather than the old one through private property.
