Are reflective flues and other roof protuberances painted?	
Are lighting fixtures opaque so that the bulbs are not visible?

If flood lights are used, are they shielded and aimed so that the glare from the bulb will not be visible from the road or adjacent properties?	
Are satellite dishes located so as to be as inconspicuous?	
Is the driveway drainage satisfactory?	
Is the adjacent paved road free of mud and gravel from construction?	
Have all of the following been removed: construction debris, building materials and excavated dirt?	
Has the site been restored so the disturbances from heavy equipment are not evident, or is a plan in place?
